**Note:** Final placement is subject to adjustment by the Parade Marshals at their discretion depending on conditions on the day of the parade – Sunday, May 15, 2022.

If your group wants to be judged during the competition, please respond to this email immediately with your group name, category, and information for the announcer to read as you pass the reviewing stage

### **PARADE STAGING AREAS:**

**SECTION A1:** the North side of Market beginning at Beaumont.

**SECTION A2:** the North side of Market beginning at Beaumont.

**SECTION A3:** the South side of Market beginning at Beaumont

**SECTION A4:** the South side of Market beginning at Beaumont

**PLEASE NOTE:** All buses must arrive at the staging area of Compton & Market. School buses dropping off band participants will be advised by the Parade Marshals in this location of where to complete drop off. Bus parking is at 7th Street and Chestnut. Buses will be staged facing eastbound on Chestnut between 7th and 11th St. The parade **will end at 7th and Market**. After your unit completes the parade route, participants will disperse and will be directed to go left on 7th Street, in which they should return to the buses.

**All parade participants will be given their parade passes when they arrive** at their designated parade assembly section from the assigned Parade Marshal and must place parade passes in the front car windows of all vehicles to be included in the parade.

Parade Marshals will not allow you to enter more vehicles than noted in your registration. Group leaders for walkers and bands must always have their parade pass in their possession. NO EXCEPTIONS!!

PARTICIPANTS ATTEMPTING TO ENTER PARADE OUT OF ORDER WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE PARADE. IF YOU ARE REMOVED FROM THE PARADE, YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE A REFUND.

ALL PARTICIPANTS WHO ARRIVE LATE MUST GO TO COMPTON AND MARKET. YOU MUST ENTER FROM COMPTON AND PROCEED SOUTH TO MARKET. PARADE MARSHALS WILL DIRECT ALL ENTRIES.

## PARADE RULES AND ORDERS

1. We expect you to be in your position at the proper place and time as indicated on your orders. **WE CANNOT GUARANTEE PARADE ORDER FOR LATE ARRIVALS. ALL PARTICIPANTS WHO ARRIVE LATE MUST GO TO MARKET & COMPTON.** YOU MUST ENTER FROM COMPTON AND PROCEED SOUTH TO MARKET. PARADE MARSHALS WILL DIRECT ENTRIES TO MAKE LEFT TURN ON MARKET.
2. PARTICIPANTS ATTEMPTING TO ENTER PARADE OUT OF ORDER **WILL BE REMOVED** FROM THE PARADE.
3. NEW PARTICIPANTS **WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED** THE DAY OF THE PARADE.
4. There will be NO DISTRIBUTION OF HANDBILLS, CANDIES, TAPES, LEAFLETS, ETC., from cars or floats along the Parade route. Participants must walk towards the crowd to distribute items. No throwing! **SAFETY FIRST!**
5. The **PARADE JUDGES** will be located on Market 1520 Market St. – southeast corner. We respectfully request that groups do not linger in front of the judges or the reviewing stand. It is important to keep the parade moving smoothly.
6. PLEASE REMEMBER, **THE PARADE IS FOR THE ENTIRE COMMUNITY, INCLUDING CHILDREN.** INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR INCLUDING PROVOCATIVE DANCING AND VULGAR/DEGRADING OR EXTREMELY LOUD MUSIC WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. **PARADE MARSHALS HAVE BEEN ASSIGNED TO REMOVE ALL PARTICIPANTS WHOSE BEHAVIOR IS NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

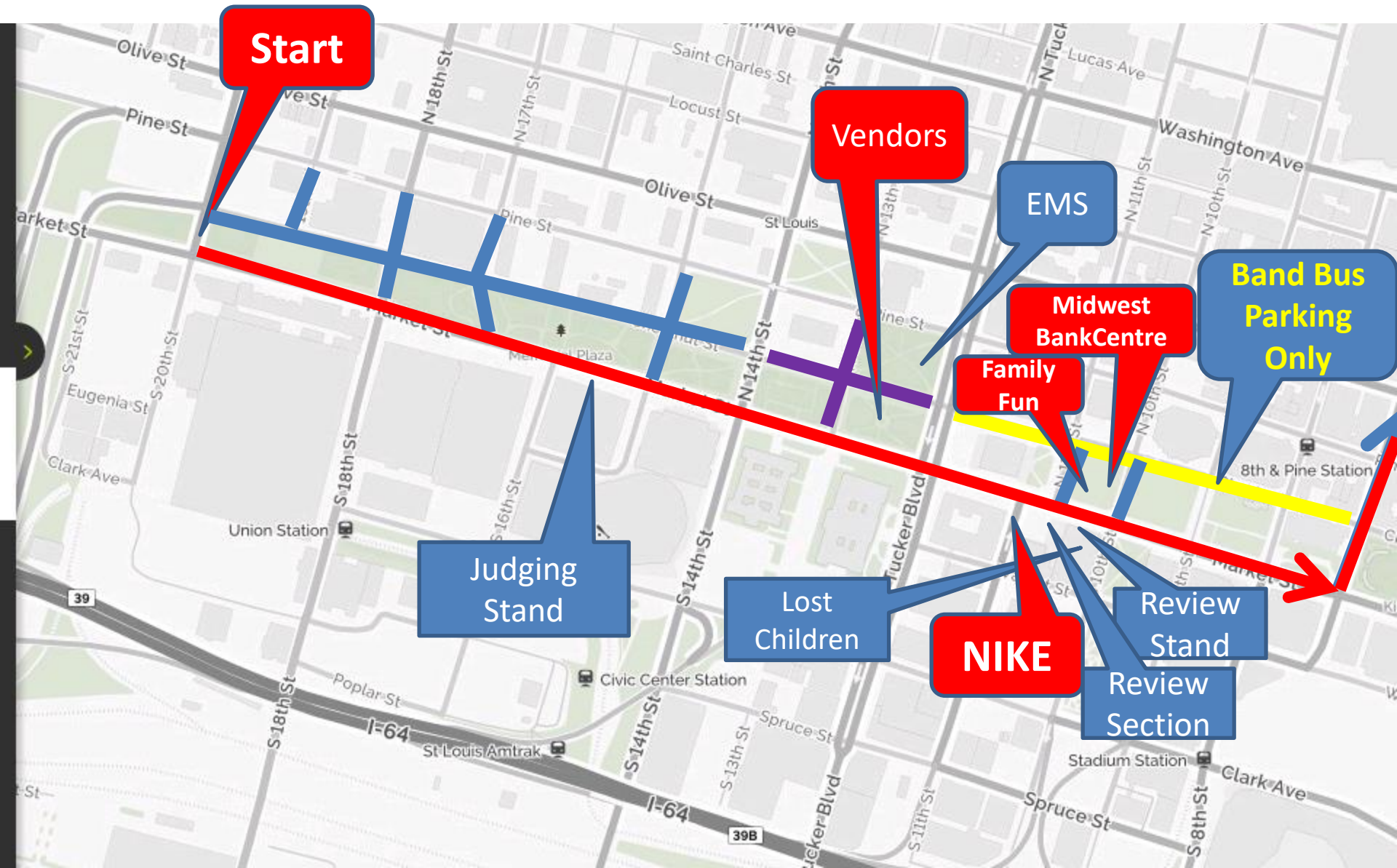

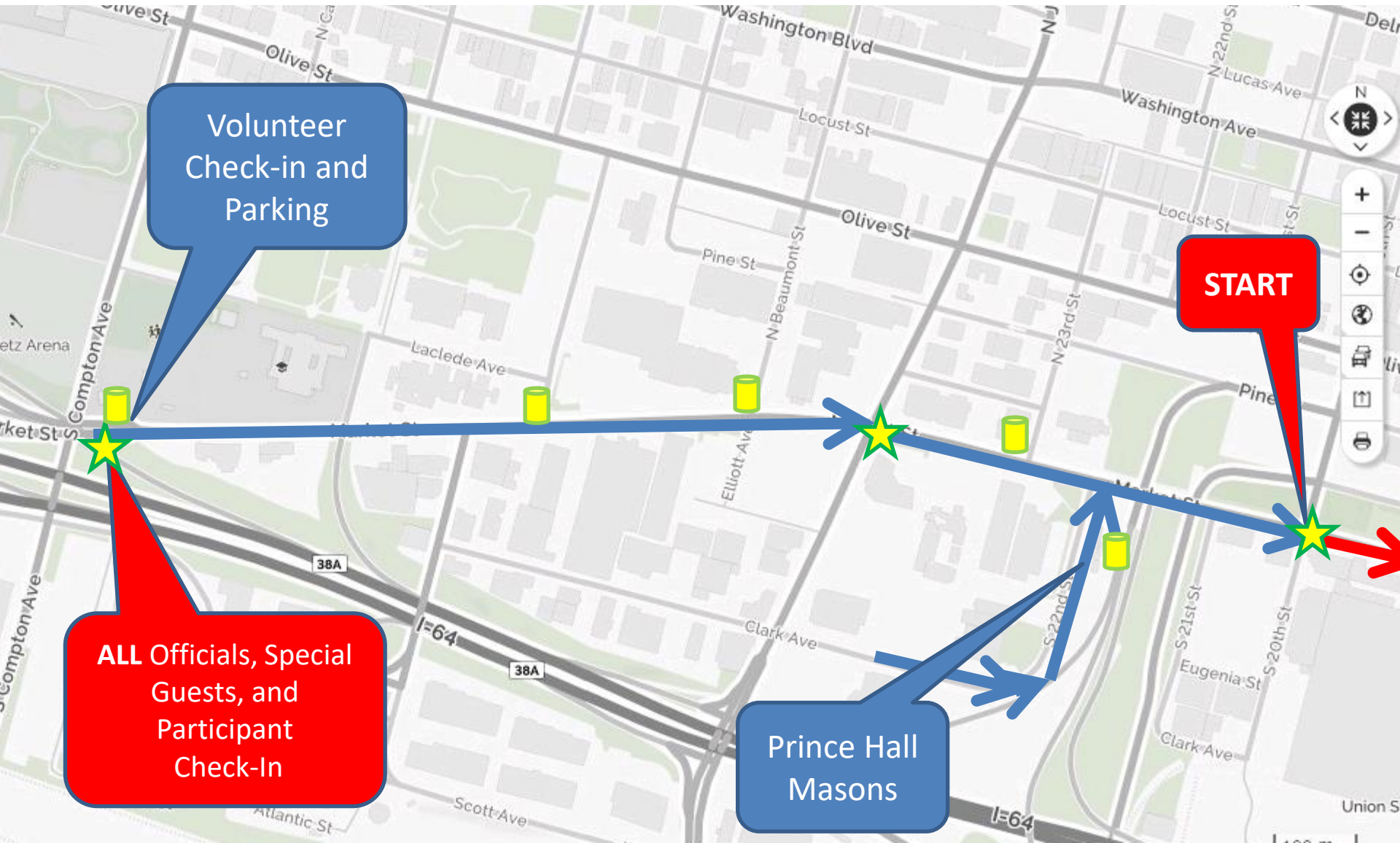

## Services For Adolescent And Family Empowered Recovery

- Intensive Outpatient Services (IOP) for Substance Abuse Treatment
- Children 12-17 years old
- Provide transportation to and from program
- Weekly group therapy
- Peer recovery support
- Individual and family therapy
- Parental support and treatment
- Evidence-Based Therapeutic Practices
  - Dialectical Behavioral Therapy (DBT)
  - Trauma informed
  - Motivational Interviewing

## Parent Cafes

- Empower parents and increase parental support within the community
- An evidence-based model
- Strengthen the Five Protective Factors, which are proven to strengthen families and family self-sufficiency
- Provide crucial social support that builds resilience and strength
- Parents find that they are more stable in various aspects of their lives, including relationships and job stability

## Therapeutic Services

Breaking down the stigma of mental health care by providing in-home, office, or virtual reality therapy to individuals and families overcoming past traumas and working towards a brighter future.

## Comprehensive Parent In-Home Advocacy & Education Program

- 24-week Intensive In-Home Intervention
- Weekly In-Home Triple P Parenting Education
- Parental rights advocacy
- Case Management to assist in completion of court mandates
- Strengthening family connection
- Respite services up to 12 years old
- Therapeutic Crisis Intervention
- Community resource referrals
- Funding to support reunification includes rent assistance, utility, housing, basic needs, food
- Parent Aide services assists with daily life skills
- Clinical evaluations to display growth and areas of improvement

## Supervised Visits

- Conduct one-on-one observations of parent-child interactions
- Assess target behaviors and interactional style, providing insight into the parent and child relationships
- Utilize a self-regulatory approach that provides parents with the resources to effectively problem solve by reinforcing parental successes and self-reflection
- Visits occur in the Annie Malone Visitation Center or the parent's home (a community setting may be an alternative if needed)

## Diaper Bank

Ensure access to an adequate supply of diapers and wipes

## Crisis

Services provide a safe 24 hour environment for children birth - 12 with intervention measures to immediately alleviate crisis by providing emergency shelter, food, clothing, educational needs, conflict resolution, emergency medical attention, and counseling referrals. The program helps to prevent child abuse and neglect by reducing parental stress, improving family communication skills, and mitigating future crisis.

## Parenting Education Group

- Eight-week group class
- Evidence based Triple P Parenting Curriculum
- Individualized sessions to assess for retention and practice
- Clinical assessments to identify parental strengths and future goals

## Annie Malone Academy

Promotes successful learning behaviors and outcomes for students, grades K thru 12 with Individual Education Plans (IEPs). Students that are successful with therapeutic programming will be able to return to their regular school environment and advance to the next academic level. Based on the student's needs, students receive individual and group therapy along with family resources. Staff also engages the families with various parent involvement activities.

## Heat Prevention Tips

Prior to the parade increase your intake of non-alcoholic beverages such as juice and water. Drink plenty of water
